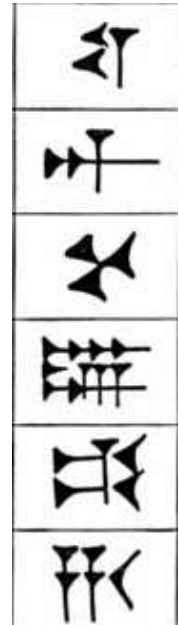
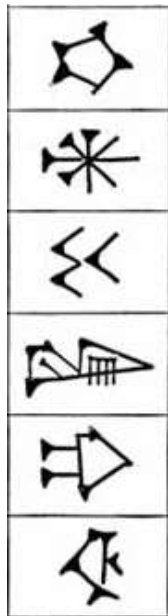

Why is ancient Iraq so important in world history? The first cities and writing developed in Mesopotamia in c. 3500 BCE. The Sumerians, Babylonians and Assyrians built empires and wrote thousands of texts in cuneiform (wedge-shaped) script until c. 75 CE. Combining modern scholarship with archaeology, art and texts, including the evocative epic of Gilgamesh, we explore Mesopotamia's rich heritage.
