Conditions Attached to the Award of Development Grants

All BISI Development Grants are subject to a number of conditions as set out below.

Successful applicants for BISI Development Grants must undertake:

- to spend the funds provided by BISI for the purposes and in accordance with the breakdown of costs and timescale set out in the grant application;
- to inform BISI of any grants from other bodies that are received for the project or event supported by BISI;
- to return the BISI grant money to BISI if the project is not undertaken within a year of the date proposed on the grant application form;
- to acknowledge the support provided by BISI at all events, in all publicity material, and in all publications resulting from the grant and to donate two copies of any publication (including brochures and programmes) to BISI;
- within 6 months of the project or event supported by BISI being undertaken, to provide a full statement of the ways in which the money provided by BISI has been spent with receipts, and to refund any money that has not been spent;
- within 6 months of the project or event supported by BISI being undertaken, to provide a short report on the project or event that may, with editing if necessary, be published in the BISI Newsletter;
- if requested, to give a short presentation on the project or event supported by BISI, principally to BISI members;
- if requested, to provide BISI with an appropriate quantity of photographic material and/or text that may be used for BISI exhibition and publicity purposes.
